THE ROBERT JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The McHenry County Federation of Teachers, Local 1642, presents one (1) scholarship award in the amount of \$2,500. This is a one-time award and is not renewable.

ELIGIBILITY

The award is given to the son or daughter of a currently employed active member in good standing of the Illinois Federation of Teachers and the McHenry County Federation of Teachers, Local 1642. This includes the following member councils: The Woodstock Council of Teachers, The Woodstock School Related Personnel, The Woodstock Custodial Council, The Woodstock Transportation Employees Council and the McHenry County College Staff Council). The son or daughter of a deceased member of the McHenry County Federation of Teachers who was in good standing with the Local at the time of his/her death is also eligible. The applicant must be a high school senior who will graduate this year before July 31. The award is entirely unrestricted as to race, religion, political affiliation or choice of accredited college, university, business, trade or vocational school.

HOW TO APPLY

Please make certain the application is completed in full as well as signed by you and by your parent or guardian so that membership in good standing can be verified before presentation to the Scholarship Committee.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THIS APPLICATION:

1. An official transcript
2. A list of co-curricular activities
3. College entrance test scores, when appropriate
4. A list of all other monetary scholarships or awards the applicant has (or expects to) received
5. Applicant's work/employment record (including any volunteer work), including type of work, approximate number of years, approximate hours per week
6. A brief statement from the applicant: "What I hope to gain from a post-secondary education" (See Page 4)
7. A Letter of Recommendation from a teacher, dean, counselor or other educator
8. The application must be signed by the parent or guardian (Local 1642 member).

Applications not containing ALL of the above information will not be considered for the scholarship award.

This application must be received by **4:00 p.m. on February 27, 2019**.
